Lizzy Borden rocks out solo

He's back!

Lizzy Borden — the heavy metal vocalist whose name emblemized an early '80s theatrical rock band — has returned to the stage as a solo singer with a new album and a Jackson performance.

Borden, whose album *Master of Disguise* is being promoted during a world tour, appears in Jackson Saturday at 10 p.m. at The Creek, 1100 S. West St. Tickets are \$10 at the door.

The former band Lizzy Borden took its name from its lead singer who teamed up with drummer Joey Scott, bassist Mychal Davis and a series of guitarists to produce such albums as *Give 'Em The Axe* and *Visual Lies*.

After the band broke up, vocalist Borden took his career solo with the help of drummer Scott; guitarist David Michael Phillips; and bassist Joey Vera, on the new, "darker" *Disguise*. It's Lizzy Borden's best-selling album.

Gunslinger — featuring Michael Maxx, former bassist for Lillian Axe — will open the show.
